Out of the Blue is an after-school arts club run by Bluecoat (Liverpool) in partnership with Norton Priory Museum.

The club will run weekly during term time from January 2019 and is aimed at children from years 3 and 4.

The club is for up to 20 pupils. All materials will be provided.

Sessions will be delivered by an Artist Facilitator, Norton Priory's Learning Officer and two members of the new Norton Priory Blue Room project for young learning disabled adults.

OOTB requires support from one member of teaching staff. This ensures smooth running of the clubs and provides a fantastic CPD opportunity for school staff to work alongside an artist practitioner.

Pupils will :

- Learn about different art styles, methods and artists.
- Make a range of art pieces in a variety of materials.
- Work alongside an artist and adults with learning disabilities.
- Be invited to attend free holiday activity days at Norton Priory Museum, for which transport will be provided.
- Create art journals that document their progress.
- Work towards Discover and Explore Arts Award accreditation throughout the project.
- Be invited to free family days at Norton Priory Museum throughout the year.
